**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR 2 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR REFUGEE STUDENTS ENROLLING
IN A MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMME TAUGHT IN ENGLISH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF
VERONA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027**

ART. 1 Purposes, conditions and terms

The main purpose of the University Corridors for Refugees – UNICORE 8.0 Project (Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Ethiopia, India, Kenya, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, South Africa, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe) is to promote the right to higher education for refugees through study corridors from Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Ethiopia, India, Kenya, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, South Africa, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe to Italy.

The Project is jointly promoted by the following organizations:

- Caritas Italiana
- Centro Astalli per Rifugiati
- Banca Etica
- Diaconia Valdese
- Gandhi Caritas
- Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI)
- United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR)

and the Italian Universities that have signed the National Protocol as part of the UNICORE Project. This *Call* is open to applicants who have qualified for international protection, are living in Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Ethiopia, India, Kenya, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, South Africa, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe and have been pre-admitted to a Master's Degree programme among those specified in Article 3.

Benefits are assigned for the academic years 2026/2027 and 2027/2028. Financial and merit requirements and additional scholarship renewal conditions are set out in Art. 6.

1.2 During their degree programme, the scholarship holders will benefit from the following:

- A scholarship amounting to € 5200 per year of study, gross of taxes required by law, to be paid by University and the scholarship holder. The grant will be paid in two instalments and subject to the scholarship holders achieving the relevant academic requirements. At the time of their enrolment, admitted applicants will be provided with further information (UNIVERSITY OF VERONA);
- Free intensive and annual Italian language course at the University Language Centre - CLA (UNIVERSITY OF VERONA);
- A laptop (UNIVERSITY OF VERONA);
- Counselling and psychological support (UNIVERSITY OF VERONA);

- Full exemption from student fees (UNIVERSITY OF VERONA);
- Pocket money of €1,000 (contribution from University of Verona Student Council for the first year; from Fondazione Biondani Ravetta for the 2nd year);
- Student tutoring on arrival and during the year by a student who will support the scholars' integration into university life and study organisation (UNIVERSITY OF VERONA);
- Financial support of 150 € monthly for 3 months for the purchase of necessities (Migrantes - Pastoral Center for Immigrants);
- Financial support of 100 € on arrival in Italy to cover necessities (Waldensian Diaconate);
- Annual subscription to local public transport from the arrival and for the duration of the two-year study program (Municipality of Verona);
- Accommodation from September 2026 and for the entire period of study, amounting to 30 months, considering the necessary acclimatisation period (partners and supporters of UNICORE);
- Health care screening (Cesaim);
- Reception actions and services for the integration in the local context (Nigrizia Foundation; CESTIM, Migrantes - Pastoral Center for Immigrants, and other local partners);
- Legal advice (CADUS);
- Coverage of the costs related to obtaining the CIMEA Statement of Comparability (Waldensian Diaconate);
- Financial support for administrative fees for applying for the Permit of Stay for Study Reasons and for its following renewals (for a maximum of two renewals) (Waldensian Diaconate);
- Coverage of the regional tax and stamp duty for the right to study to be paid to the region (Institute of Charity of the Sacred Heart, Sisters of Don Nicola Mazza);
- Full coverage of pre-arrival expenses, i.e. flight tickets (University of Verona), visa-related and administrative costs (National Partners);
- Additional Italian language course (CESTIM);
- A SIM card and the first month's subscription included (Waldensian Diaconate);
- Accompaniment of administrative procedures and access to local Services (Waldensian Diaconate);
- Costs related to enrollment in the National Health Service and any necessary language mediation services (Diocesan Caritas of Verona);
- Canteen card including one meal per day for free, to be used at the University canteens managed by ESU (ESU Verona);
- Enrollment in the healthcare system and eventual service of language mediation (partners and supporters of UNICORE);



- Internship at the Fondazione Nigrizia structures (Nigrizia Foundation);
- Activation of services related to the Community Centre desk in Verona (dealing with administrative paperwork, facilitating access to local services, work orientation, support for social inclusion) (Waldensian Diaconate);
- Helping with administrative procedures and access to services in the area (Waldensian Diaconate);
- Planning and procurement of services aimed at autonomy (OBTI);
- Eventual purchase of bedding items, dishes and cleaning products if those are not provided by the accommodation (Waldensian Diaconate);
- Verona card for free access to city museums from the arrival and for the duration of the two-year study program (Municipality of Verona).

ART. 2 – Incompatibility

The UNICORE 8.0 scholarships cannot be combined with:

- study grants/prizes for international students awarded by the University of Verona on the basis of merit or financial requirements;
- study grants awarded by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI);
- CRUI grants for those who have qualified for international protection.

ART. 3 - International Master's Degree programmes available and admission requirements

3.1 Applicants can choose to apply for one of the following International Master's Degree programmes of the University of Verona:

Artificial Intelligence

Biology for Translational Research and Precision Medicine

Computer Engineering for Intelligent System

Data Science

Economics and Data Analysis

Languages, Literatures and Digital Culture

Linguistics

Mathematics



3.2 This call is open exclusively to applicants who:

1. Are residing in Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Ethiopia, India, Kenya, Mozambique, Niger, Nigeria, South Africa, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe and have been recognised the refugee status in collaboration with UNHCR;
2. Hold a qualification valid for admission to the chosen master's degree programme;
3. The qualification must have been obtained, no earlier than 2021, in a higher education institution accredited by the Ministry of Education of the country that issued the qualification, and must allow local access to a second level degree course;
4. Have a cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of at least 3.0 under the tertiary education grading system of the country of graduation (equivalent to or higher than 60%);
5. Meet the specific admission requirements of the relevant master's degree programme (see Annex 2);
6. Have never been enrolled before in a degree programme at the University of Verona, or any of the Partner Universities;
7. Have completed previous university studies in English, or having obtained an official English language certification as specified in the Annex "Admission Requirements" for each Master International Degree Programme.

ART. 4 - Selection criteria and application documents

4.1 Candidates are selected on the basis of merit requirements.

The first assessment of applications (Step 1) will be carried out by the Teaching Committee of each Master's degree programme. The first 8 applicants in the list of eligible applicants, ranked in descending order of score (see Art. 5), will be asked to take part in an online interview with a Selection Committee (Step 2), that will be subsequently appointed by decree of the Rector of the University of Verona.

4.2 Applicants will need to submit the following documents:

1. The application for the call can be submitted through the UNHCR website <https://universitycorridors.unhcr.it/>



2. A copy of their currently valid *Refugee Identity Card* issued in collaboration with UNHCR, or a *PoR Card*;
3. A certificate proving that the applicant holds the qualification required for admission to the relevant Master's Degree programme;
4. A *Transcript of Records* including exams passed and corresponding marks;
5. A cover letter (maximum two A4 pages);
6. English language proficiency certificate as required by the chosen Master's Degree programme only in absence of an English taught academic study programme;
7. Optional: reference letter/s by a supervisor/advisor and any other document which may be considered to support the application.

At this stage, documents issued in languages other than English, French, Spanish, German or Italian can be translated into English by the applicant.

4.3 Applications may be submitted from 2 March 2026 to 17 April 2026, by 7.00 pm (UTC +2). Students will need to submit their application, including all the documents listed at point 4.2 above, via the UNICORE website, at: <https://universitycorridors.unhcr.it/>. Once the application has been submitted, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to the e-mail address provided by the applicant in the online form. Applications that are incomplete or not properly filled out will not be accepted. Students shall apply for one or more Master's Degree programmes offered by the University of Verona, and for a maximum of two partner Universities – including the University of Verona – that are part of the UNICORE 8.0 Project. Please note that this is a mandatory requirement: failure to comply with this clause will result in immediate rejection of the application.

ART. 5 - Selection process

The selection process is divided into two steps:

- Step 1: assessment of documentation;
- Step 2: online interview.

5.1 Step 1: assessment of documentation

The Selection Committee will assess the documentation according to the following criteria:

- CV and relevance of the academic training (Bachelor's degree and any Master's) and extra-academic activities (internships, summer schools, work activities, etc.) with the objectives of the course of study (score: 0-25);



- Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA or equivalent) (score: 0 -15)

At the end of Step 1, a merit-based ranking list will be drawn up and made available on the relevant web page on the University's website (www.univr.it): only the first 8 candidates, ranked in descending order of score, will have access to Step 2, the online interview. Where two or more candidates have an equal score, priority will be given to the younger candidate.

Candidates admitted to Step 2 will be notified by email by 15 May 2026. The partial ranking will also be published on the website www.univr.it on the page dedicated to the initiative.

5.2 Step 2: Online interview

All candidates admitted to Step 2 must attend an interview with the Selection Committee. The interview will assess the candidate's knowledge of the relevant Master's Degree programme, their technical and fundamental logical and mathematical skills, as well as their communication skills and English language proficiency. Interviews will take place during May and June 2026 and will be held online via Zoom.

Candidates will be notified by email of the date and time of the interview and the relevant deadlines will be also made available on the relevant web page on the University's website (www.univr.it).

At the interview, candidates will need to bring their *Refugee Identity Card* or *PoR card* used during the online application. In addition, a third person must be present at the beginning of the interview to identify the candidate. Interviews will be assessed on a 40 points scale.

5.3 - Final list of eligible applicants

Scholarship holders must represent both genders. If it is not possible to ensure representation of both genders among the selected candidates, any vacant positions may be assigned to candidates of the same gender, while always respecting the order of merit and the scores obtained.

The final list of eligible applicants based on merit (*graduatoria*) is drawn up by the Selection Committee: total point scores for each applicant are calculated by adding up the scores from Step 1 and Step 2. Candidates who score less than 50/80 points will not be included in the final list of eligible applicants. Candidates will be ranked in descending order of score. Where two or more candidates have an equal score, priority will be given to the younger candidate.

The final list will be then approved by Rector's Decree. The scholarship holders will be informed via email and the final list will be published on the relevant web page on the University's website www.univr.it by 22 June 2026.



5.4 - Accepting the scholarship

The selected applicants must accept the scholarship offer in writing by replying to the University's e-mail within 10 days of receiving it. Failing to accept the offer by the given deadline will result in the candidates being automatically removed from the selection process.

By accepting the scholarship, the candidates fully and unconditionally accept UNICORE 8.0 Project support and financial benefits under the conditions established in this *Call for applications* and declares under their full responsibility that they do not fall under any of the conditions of incompatibility set out in Article 2 above.

5.5 - Before departure

Before moving to Italy, the scholarship holders will be responsible for keeping in touch with the University and the local project coordinators. They will also be required to attend an introductory Italian language course and other preparatory activities prior to their arrival in Italy, as well as to follow the instructions given on site for their integration into the University system and the relevant Master's Degree programme, or else they will have their scholarship revoked.

5.6 - Withdrawals and allocation of vacant scholarships

In case of withdrawal, or if the requirements in preparation for the transfer indicated in Article 5.5 are not met by 14 August 2026, the scholarship will be allocated to the next eligible candidate in the list of eligible applicants.

Should any scholarship remain vacant, the University of Verona reserves the right to select an alternative candidate from the lists of other partner Universities. Eligible candidates must meet the specific requirements of the Master's Degree programmes of the University of Verona.

ART. 6 - Scholarship and benefits renewal requirements

In order to be eligible for renewal of the scholarship, the scholarship holders must earn 30 University credits (CFU) by 30 September 2027. In order to maintain the scholarship, the scholarship holders are required to earn 60 university credits by 30 September 2028.

The scholarship holders are also required to graduate by the last graduation session available, i.e. April 2029, after which the scholarship and associated benefits shall not be extended.



ART. 7 - Withdrawing from studies

If a scholarship holder withdraws from the programme during their studies, they will automatically lose all the benefits of the scholarship and their residence permit for study.

ART. 8 - Processing of personal data

Personal data provided by those who apply for students support benefits under this *Call* are processed in accordance with EU Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter the “Regulation”) and the applicable personal data protection regulations.

The processing of such data is carried out by the University of Verona as Data Controller pursuant to Articles 24 et seq. of the Regulation, for the purposes set out in the present *Call*, in the performance of its institutional functions.

Pursuant to Art. 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, the University reserves the right to check the truthfulness of any information received. If a declaration is found to be false or misleading, the applicant will lose the right to apply for this *Call* and/or any benefits granted.
