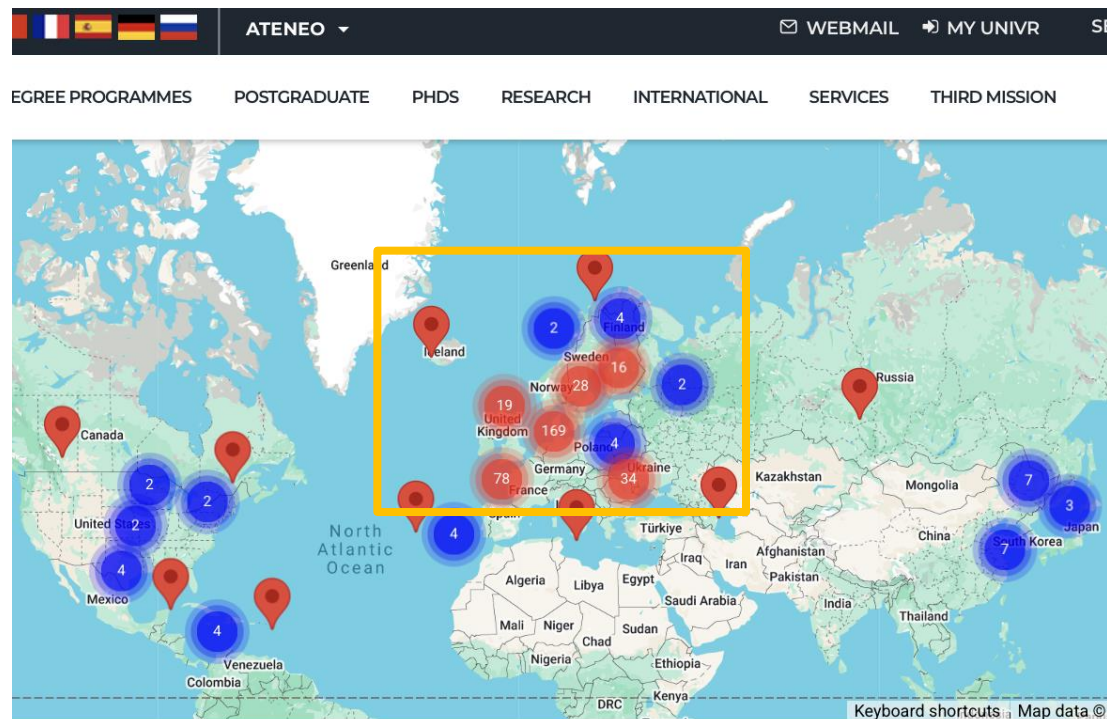

1. Erasmus+ Study

- Staying abroad (**EU destination**) to study: 2 to 12 months
- Allows students:
 - **Attend classes and give exams**
 - Use destination university's facilities
 - Exam validation & Credit transfer @ UNIVR
- **Call for Applications 2026-2027: OPEN**
- It is mandatory to obtain at least 12 CFU per semester of international mobility, otherwise the Erasmus+ Scholarship must be refunded

Mobility period: Sep 15, 2025 – Sep 30, 2026

Requirement: Learning Agreement for Traineeship with host institution + UniVR tutor

Post-graduation mobility: allowed if applied ≥ 1 month before graduation; must start within 1 year after degree and end by Sep 30, 2026

- Usually, it opens in November

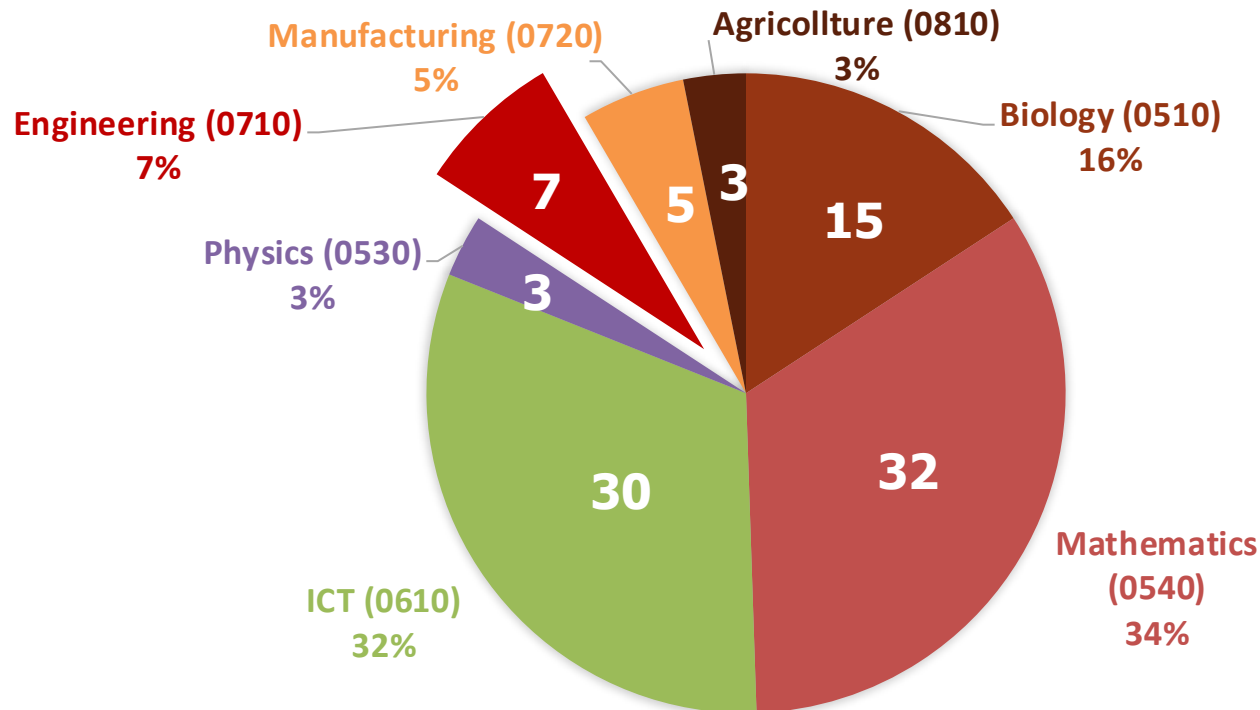

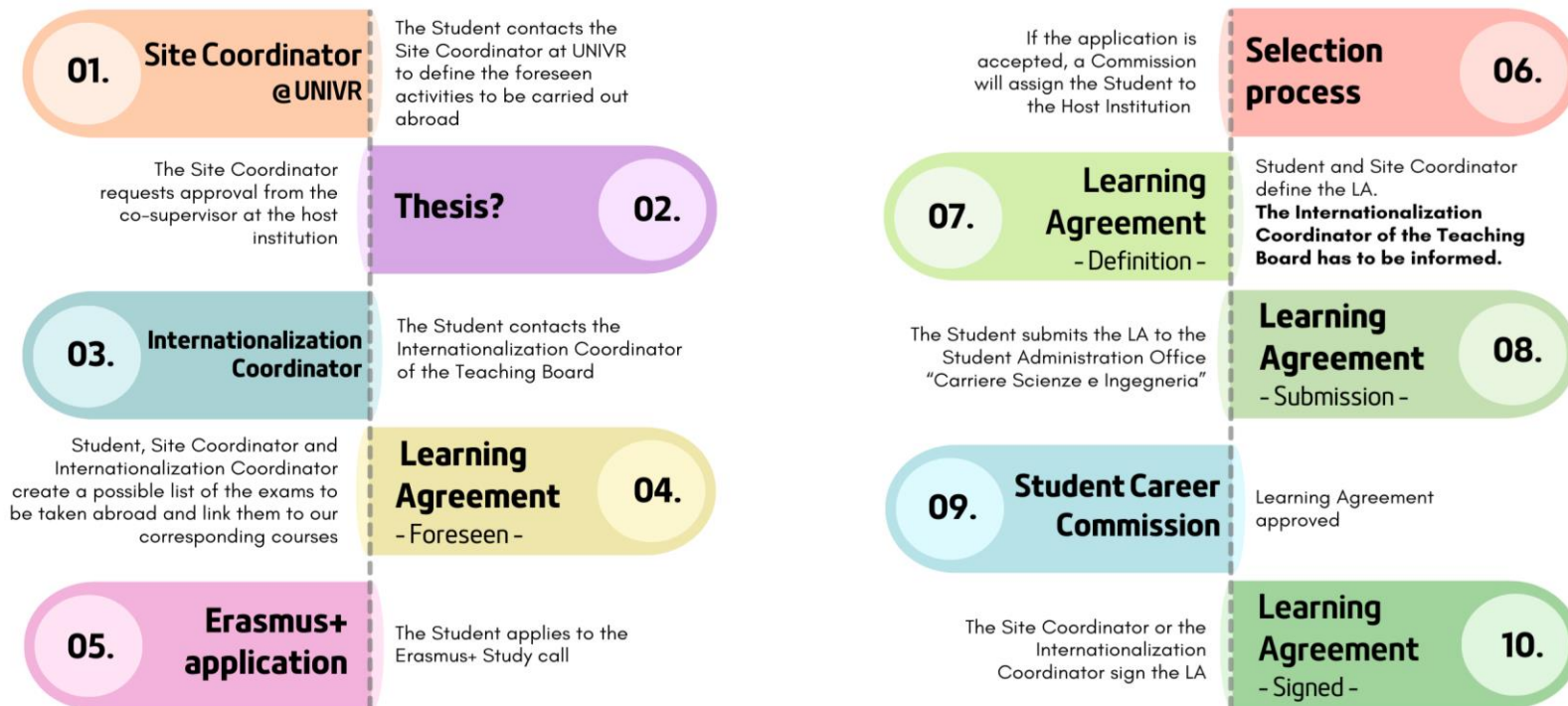

Who should I contact for my Learning Agreement?

MANDATORY! Contact the university **SITE COORDINATOR**

- to define activities/exams (e.g. Prof. Muradore for Technical University of Cluj-Napoca, Romania)
- to draft **Learning Agreement** with the courses to be taken abroad

Submit **Erasmus+ application** → undergo Evaluation

Agreement finalization: define, submit, and approve the **Learning Agreement**

Final signature of the agreement & validation by **STUDENT PROCEDURES COMMISSION - COMMISSIONE PRATICHE STUDENTI** (Prof. Muradore, Dr. Lora, Dr. Bontempi, Dr. Boscolo Galazzo, Prof. Maniglio, Prof. Setti, Prof. Tamellin)

Students from degree programs aligned with the ISCED code will have priority

The total amount of the Scholarship depends on the country of destination
