Acceptance Letters	Non-EU students: official invitation letters for visa purposes are sent only after the application has been submitted (including correct learning agreement). EU students will receive a confirmation of acceptance by e-mail.

Accommodation (Housing)	See the website Ask for support to International Welcome Desk – IWD
Visa and stay permit	EU citizens do not need visa and stay permit. Non-EU citizens need to obtain a visa before arrival. Once arrived, they have to apply for a stay permit for study reasons. Ask for support to International Welcome Desk – IWD .
Insurance	Exchange students are covered by the insurance policies of the University of Verona.
Health Insurance	Valid health insurance covering the study period in Italy is compulsory. EU citizens are recommended to bring European Health Insurance Card EHIC. Non-EU Citizens are recommended to obtain a private health insurance. Ask for support to International Welcome Desk – IWD
Cost of Living	The currency in Italy is Euro (€). Student life in Verona costs approximately € 1000 per month
