COURSE GRADING MATCH

European higher education systems employ different national grading scales. Partners involved in double degree programmes should therefore agree in advance how they will deal with grading and transfer of grades.

To ensure transparent and consistent information on individual student performance, European institutions usually provide a statistical distribution table of the passing grades awarded in each programme or field of study. Grade distribution tables of partner institutions may be compared in order to define an appropriate grade conversion scheme.

Alternatively, the grade conversion table can also be based on previous experience from exchange agreements, or on mutual understanding of the respective student assessment systems.

Whenever possible, conversion tables should establish a direct correspondence of each grade expressed on the Italian thirty-point scale and the equivalent grades of the partner institution. Otherwise, detailed guidance on the conversion process should be provided. An example of a grade conversion table is provided below.

Grades not explicitly listed in the table shall be rounded up to the nearest higher international grade (e.g. 18 -> 6).

FINAL THESIS GRADING METHODS

The procedures for awarding the final degree grade may vary significantly from country to country. The Italian system, which adds the thesis score to the final grade average, represents an exception. In most other countries, the thesis generally contributes to the final average with a weighted value. For this reason, the final degree grade may vary considerably, even when starting from the same initial grade average.

For this reason, it would be preferable for each of the involved universities to award the academic degree in accordance with its own regulations, assigning the final grade independently and using its own grading methodology.

Otherwise, a final grades conversion table should be provided, similar to the conversion table of examination marks.
