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ABOUT

I studied with Emanuele Severino, arguably Italy's leading philosopher in the 20th century, at the university "Ca' Foscari" of Venice, where I received my MA in 1995 and my PhD in 2004 on the intellectual landscape of the School of Chartres. From 2007 to 2010 I received a post-doc from the University of Verona, where in 2011 I became tenured Assistant Professor of Ethics at the Department of Human Sciences. In January 2016 I was visiting fellow (*Guestprofessor*) at the University of Oldenburg, Germany, for the PhD program (*Graduiertenkolleg*) «Praktiken der Subjektivierung». From 1999 to 2010, I worked in Venice as a civil servant at the Italian Ministry for Cultural Heritage. The fascination exerted by the masterpieces of Giorgione, Titian, and Veronese inspired researches on the relation between philosophy and painting, and later culminated in a fellowship at the Kunsthistorisches Museum of Vienna (April-May 2016) and the organization of an international conference (see the "Dissemination" section). In 2018 I was awarded the national scientific qualification for Associate Professor, a role I took up in 2019. Since 2010 my research interests gradually shifted from history of philosophy to ethics and bioethics. From 2016 to 2022 I sat on the board of the Italian Society of Ethics. From 2018, I have always been part of various medical ethics committees of the Veneto region. From 2015 to 2024, I founded and oversaw the research centers Asklepios—Philosophy and Health and EThoS—Ethics and Technologies of the Self. In 2024 I founded two research centres: Ethics, Right, Medicine & Science (ERMES), on applied ethics, and Circolo Nietzsche Verona, for the study of Nietzsche's philosophy. In 2023 I left the Dept. of Human Sciences for the Dept. of Engineering for Innovation Medicine; shortly afterwards I was awarded the national scientific qualification for Full Professor.

TEACHING / ADMINISTRATIVE TASKS

I currently carry my teaching activity in three BAs (Biotechnologies, Nursing, and Robotics) and one MA (Data science). My teaching subjects are Bioethics (advanced) for the BA in nursing, Bioethics (basic) for the BA in Biotechnologies, and AI Ethics (basic & advanced) for the BA in Robotics and the MA in Data science. In the past I also taught Philosophical anthropology, History of medieval philosophy, and Philosophy of Religion for the BA in Philosophy. In the past I gave seminars for, and sat in the board of, the PhD in Human sciences of the University of Verona; from 2024 I seat in the board of the PhD of Molecular medicine. Beside teaching at academic level, I also provided training courses for nurses: in 2014 «Human Caring. A Philosophical Approach to Caring in Chronical Disease» for the Italian Nurses Guild of the counties of Trieste, Gorizia and Pordenone, and in 2016 «Human caring», a training course aimed at 1000 nurses of the Region of Friuli Venezia Giulia in north-eastern Italy. Up to present, I have overseen 1 PhD, 11 MA and 80 BA dissertations, whose subjects mostly cover ethical aspects (ethics of mutual recognition, care ethics, medical and global bioethics); other subjects include the analysis of some of the main authors and concepts of Western philosophical tradition. From 2017 to 2021 I coordinated the BA in Philosophy, and from 2020 to 2022 I was member of the ethical committee of the Dept. of Human Sciences. In 2023 I was appointed at the committee for Research and Quality at the Dpt. of Engineering for Innovation Medicine and senior expert at the committee for Animal Wellness of the University of Verona.

RESEARCH, DISSEMINATION, AND PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

My research activity focuses on general and applied ethics, and on Nietzsche's philosophy. My first works explored the valorization of violence by contemporary philosophy as a way to achieve greater authenticity in life. I later moved to define contemporary nihilism as a manifold denial of mutual inter-subjective recognition—the latter being, in my eyes, the proper ground for a possible refoundation of ethics. As a natural prosecution of these research, I began studying the ethics of caring and, eventually, I became interested in the philosophy of medicine, enriching my knowledge with a fruitful co-operation with medical institutions (hospitals, ethical committees, and professional associations): this led to my appointment at the Bioethics committee of the Medical Association of the Verona province in 2021, and the Ethical committee for clinical practices of the Hospitals of Verona. My research on Nietzsche, too, converges on applie ethics, and so far I have been awarded two grants. The first concerns my two-years (2021-2023) project “HEALING—HEALth and Illness in Nietzsche and the Greeks” , funded by the University of Verona with a € 60.000 research grant, explores the meaning of health and illness in Nietzsche's works and letters from a physiological perspective, evaluating whether Nietzsche's conceptions were used in, and may be useful for, medical conceptions and practices. The second concerns the project “NET—Nutrition, place, and climate. Nietzsche's environmental ethics”, funded by the European Commission with a € 220.000 research grant within the Marie Skłodowska-Curie actions framework. My research activity greatly benefits from scientific networking provided by membership of the Italian Society of Ethics (since 2011), the Nietzsche-Gesellschaft (since 2018), and the Friedrich Nietzsche Society (since 2019). To-day, I published 6 monographs, 18 papers in peer-reviewed journals (6 in English), and 32 book chapters, and I edited 7 volumes. In 2023 I worked as referee for the National Evaluation of the Quality of Scientific Research for the years 2015-2019.

Dissemination activities include the annual organisation of two cycles of conferences, one on applied ethics (focusing on bioethics, ethics of AI, and environmental ethics) and another on aspects of Nietzsche's philosophy linked to contemporary issues. In 2016, I organized in Verona three international conferences (one in 2016 and two in 2024). I am the founder and scientific director of the series "CARES-Care, Environments, Research & Society", on general and applied ethics, published by Mimesis (Milan). Finally, I have also an extended competence about public engagement: I wrote books for a wider audience and published by "Corriere della Sera", among Italy's most prestigious newspapers, as well as articles for the Italian edition of "National Geographic History", I took part in radio interviews, public debates, and theatre shows. However, my stardust career peak is undoubtedly my participation (as myself) in the movie *I, Archimedes – The Lost Codex* (2017), arguably the zenith in my race to celebrity.
