The research fellowship is part of the "University and Crisis" project (ESRC). Within this framework, I have focused my research on the founding of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem as a historical case study of the interaction between nation-building processes and university institutions. The pivotal figure of Judah Magnes (one of the founders and the first Chancellor of the Hebrew University) has been explored based on information provided by Hannah Arendt in her *The Jewish Writings*. More broadly, I have investigated how the analysis of statelessness and the critique of the nation-state in this anthology of Arendt's texts can be considered two foundational aspects of her entire political theory. In *Beyond Sovereignty: A Genealogy of Plurality and Its Political Outcomes* (book chapter, forthcoming), I present the results of my research so far, reconstructing and highlighting Arendt's involvement (between 1933 and 1948) with left-wing Zionism and her close connections with intellectuals and politicians such as Martin Buber, Kurt Blumenfeld, and Judah L. Magnes.

The establishment of this Research Centre, currently in development, is one of the objectives of my postdoctoral fellowship at the same University.
