Brief description of research activity

My research activity mainly concerns the question of the relationship between the human and nature in the light of anthropogenesis and philosophy of emotions. I've tackled this theme engaging with several philosophers, such as Plato, Spinoza, Kant, Schelling and Scheler. Especially with Schelling's philosophy of nature and Scheler's philosophical anthropology I dealt in my monograph published in German in 2012. I translated the original edition of Scheler's *Die Stellung des Menschen im Kosmos* into Italian. For two mandates (from 2013 to 2018) I was President of Max Scheler Gesellschaft. My recent works include *Periagoge* (2017) and *Biosemiotica* (2018), which focus on the problem of anthropogenesis from the perspective of a philosophy as transformation. An English edition of *Periagoge* is currently in press at Brill Publishers.
