

Curriculum Vitae (Marco Mattia)

Born in 1993, in April 2018 he graduated in law with full marks and honors from the University of Salento, discussing an experimental thesis in criminal law (entitled «Psychic causality and "Menticide": the problem of mental conditioning in single-subjective field», supervisor Prof. Luigi Cornacchia, co-supervisor Prof. Rossano Ivan Adorno).

From May 2018 to February 2019 he collaborated in the academic activities of the Criminal Law chair of the University of Salento. In April 2019 he was appointed assistant for the courses of Criminal Law, Advanced Criminal Law, Economic and Labor Criminal Law at the University of Bergamo.

From June 2018 to December 2019 he carried out (with positive outcome) the training internship pursuant at the Ordinary Court of Brindisi, Section GIP / GUP (trustee magistrate: Dr. Tea Verderosa). In 2021 he carries out the supplementary semester of forensic practice pursuant at the Giretti-Stea law firm in the city of Lecce, dealing with issues of criminal law, civil law and administrative law.

Since 1 October 2021 he has been a PhD student in criminal law at the University of Verona with a research project entitled "The relevance of psycho-emotional factors within the modern system of criminal indictment, with particular reference to the recent questions posed by the Artificial Intelligence. A new meta-theoretical perspective of criminal law?» (scientific supervisor: Prof. Roberto Flor).

On 5 October 2022 he obtained the qualification to practice the legal profession at the Court of Appeal of Lecce.
