Research interests

The research interests concern following main scientific areas. The first is Social Geography, focusing on relationships between population and territories, such as the socio-territorial effects of citizenship processes in urban spaces, with a special attention to the needs regarding quality of life, territorialisation processes, space and community relationships. Migration topic is also related to the Geography perspective, with a special attention to perceptions and representations of this topic, in the wider dynamics of marginalization and gentrification processes. The second area focuses on Cooperation and Development and the third is Education in Geography, combining Geography and territory education.

She worked both at local scale - in Verona and Lessinia - and at international scale in West Africa (in particular in Senegal), Guizhou (Cina), Piaui (Brazil).
