Present research activities and programs

With the research team based at the University of Verona composed by Martina Menon (Lecturer, Ph.D. University of York), Nicola Tommasi (Advanced Stata Programmer), including the Ph.D. students Lucia Echeverria (Universidad de Mar de Plata, Argentina) and Getachew Belete (FAO), and the Marie-Curie Fellow Eleftherios Giovanis, Federico Perali is implementing in collaboration with Prof. Jean-Paul Chavas of the University of Wisconsin both a theoretical and applied research program on *Collective Consumption, Equivalence Scales and Welfare: from the Individual to Society*. The aim is to go beyond the traditional household-based measurement of well-being to consider individual well-being based both on income and other relevant poverty dimensions. Such analysis can significantly matter for the correct analysis of equity, gender issues, and child welfare. It is also relevant for the estimation of fiscal impacts accounting for behavioral responses both at the household and individual level.

The program addresses the following themes

- Theory
 - Structural behavioural models of consumption and leisure: the collective approach and identification issues.
 - The collective household enterprise: labour supply, household technologies, household public goods, externalities.
 - Interpersonal comparisons and equivalence scales: the cost of maintaining and raising a child, indifference equivalence scales, fertility choices, means testing.
 - From household to individual and social welfare: The Collective “Jorgenson and Slesnick” Social Welfare function. Fiscal microsimulations.
- Applications
 - The collective approach with household technologies and time use using the Integrated Italian Living Standard Data Base.
 - Micro general equilibrium: The “collective family” miniature economy.
 - Child poverty: Italy, Albania, Argentina and Ethiopia.
 - Household inequality and the sharing rule.
 - Collective Engel curves: From household to individual consumption.
 - How to treat household public goods: the case of individuals and households with disabled members.
 - Fiscal microsimulations, on a collective basis, where the economic impact of a change in policy is a money metric measure of the change in social welfare.

The research team is working at writing Stata commands and associated research papers with the potential to be published in the Stata Journal for the estimation of Unit Values, Collective Engel Curves, Collective Demand Systems and Collective Social Welfare Functions.

The collective research program also includes a joint work with U. Colombino and R. Aaberge on the “*Labor Supply of Married Couples using a Collective Approach and Administrative Data.*”

The team is also involved in other two major research programs that, at present, are at the stage of dissemination of results in major field journals:

- “*Understanding the Causes of Juvenile Crime in Italy*,” using primary data from Sicily and Veneto.
- “*Disability and Well-being*” using primary data about a sample of patients who suffered heavy brain injuries for the Verona and Florence provinces.

Both research programs use a case-control epidemiological approach to implement causal analyses.

Joint with Ravi Pendakur (University of Ottawa, Department of Sociology) and Martina Menon (University of Verona), Federico Perali is undertaking the project “*Being a Big-Baby: Culture or Economics? Evidence from a Natural Experiment*” that compares the decision of leaving the parental nest of young adults living in households of Italian immigrants in Canada with the other Canadian households.

In collaboration with Ranjan Ray (Monash University, Melbourne, Australia) and Martina Menon (University of Verona) is implementing a research program on the topic “*Estimation of Italian Living Standards*” accounting for spatial price variation, the costs of public services and different household technologies using a) a pseudo-panel of cross-section of Italian household budgets, from 1999 to 2022, b) the Italian Integrated Living Standard Data Base integrating the consumption survey, standard of living survey (EU-SILC) developed in collaboration of Elena Dalla Chiara and Martina Menon, and c) household budgets of France and Germany.

In collaboration with the Economics Living Lab (<http://econlivlab.eu>), the author has developed an improvement of the Italian means-testing tool ISEE that is called Fattore Famiglia (<http://econlivlab.eu/content/isee-fattore-famiglia-modalità-di-accesso-ai-servizi-di-welfare>) and is now implemented for the Veneto region.

In collaboration with Lucio Scandizzo, Riccardo Magnani and Daniele Cufari, the author has developed the Italian Dynamic Spatial General Equilibrium Model for the evaluation of the social, economic and environmental impact of the PNRR plan.
