

Mara Migliavacca: Associated Professor in Prehistory and Protohistory, University of Verona. She co-directed the archeological fieldwork at Campetto (Recoaro, VI), and directed the archaeological research in the Agno-Leogra ridge (VI); the excavations of the Neolithic settlement of Uomo della Roccia (Cornedo, VI); the archaeological Project “Behind the border in the Veneto Prealpine highlands”; and the project “People Woods Passes” at Fraselle (Selva di Progno, VR; Crespadoro, VI) together with the Regional Park of Lessini.
