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He obtained his medical degree in 2002, his specialization in Clinical Biochemistry and Laboratory Medicine in 2007, and a PhD in Clinical and Experimental Medical Sciences from the Doctoral School in Life and Health Sciences in 2015. He has published more than 500 scientific articles and has participated in over 130 national and international conferences, delivering approximately 80 presentations at scientific conferences and meetings.

His research activity is integrated with clinical practice and focuses on preanalytical variability; the development and validation of analytical methods in clinical chemistry, liquid chromatography, mass spectrometry and immunometry; and the identification of new biochemical and molecular biomarkers for the diagnosis and monitoring of neoplastic, cardiovascular and haemostatic diseases.
