2. CLINICAL ACTIVITIES

Dr Luca Idolazzi started his clinical activities at the University of Verona, where he achieved his Degree in Medicine in Surgery in 2006. He got his Medical Qualification in March 2007. since March 2007 He attended at Osteoarticular Rehabilitation Unit – Regional Center for Osteoporosis at the Hospital of Valeggio sul Mincio. In 2007 he started his Post Graduate School in Rheumatology in the same Unit. In October 2008 he moved to Ospedale Civile Maggiore in Verona as per request of the formative program of the Post Graduate School in Rheumatology. Here he joined the outpatient clinic, the activities of Day Hospital and started collaboration with Dermatologic Unit. Since 2009 he ran an Integrated Outpatient Clinic for Psoriatic patients, cooperating with that Unit. He achieved his Post Degree in Rheumatology School – University of Verona (Director – Prof. Adami) in July 2011 with final vote of 70/70 cum laude. Since September 2011 he works as Doctor Attendant at the Rheumatologic Unit – Ospedale Civile Maggiore in Verona and from January 2012 to December 2014 he attended the Doctorate School in Clinical and Experimental Sciences of the University of Verona. He achieved the Ph D degree in April 2015.

Since March 2013 he is also Fellow Assistant in Rheumatology Unit. He especially devoted himself to imaging in rheumatology and spondyloarthritides, with a specific interest in psoriatic arthritis. Since March 2021 he is associated professor in

Rheumatology and he moved to Policlinico G. B. Rossi to follow patients affected by systemic sclerosis and psoriatic arthritis

3. SCIENTIFIC PRODUCTION

Dr. Idolazzi started his scientific activities at Osteoarticular Rehabilitation Unit – Regional Center for Osteoporosis at the Hospital of Valeggio sul Mincio. His research was first in the field of osteoporosis and then in the physiopathology of rheumatic diseases involving bone (algodistrophy, osteogenesis imperfecta, Paget's disease, rheumatoid arthritis, psoriatic arthritis, early arthritis).

Since 2007 he works as subinvestigator in research protocols and clinical trials for the treatment of rheumatic diseases (rheumatoid arthritis, psoriatic arthritis, osteoporosis). He is also involved in scientific projects and clinical trials for the Rheumatological Unit and for the S.I.R. (Società Italiana di Reumatologia). He is member of several advisory board and study groups (GRAPPA and OMERACT)
