

**Elisa Sartor** is Associate Professor of Spanish Language, Translation and Linguistics at the University of Verona.

She is the author of about 45 publications, many of them dedicated to: a) the application of digital humanities to linguistic research, with a special attention to corpus linguistics, b) the diachronic study of specialized lexicon through Spanish texts and dictionaries, c) Spanish lexicography as well as d) translation studies. Furthermore, she has presented about 25 papers at international conferences and seminars.
