I am 25 years old and I am a PhD student at the Department of Human Sciences, Sociology curriculum, in Verona. My ongoing research project aims to analyze the caregiver population category, hypothesizing - in a structural interactionist perspective - an inverse correlation between perceived discomfort and the use of formal forms of support. By investigating the impact that formal support has on the well-being of the informal caregiver, it will be possible to indicate the factors that limit its adoption. This analysis will allow us to define effective intervention models and facilitate the planning of more accessible and targeted services, capable of alleviating the care burden and improving the quality of life of both caregivers and those assisted.
