ACADEMIC AND SCIENTIFIC PROFILE

Bio: After graduating *cum laude* in Foreign Languages at the University of Bologna in 2003, Chiara Melloni got a Ph.D. in Linguistics at the University of Verona in 2007. She has been a *visiting student* at the University of Essex (2005; sponsor: Prof. Andrew Spencer) and a *visiting scholar* at the University of New Hampshire (2006; sponsor: Prof. Rochelle Lieber). In 2007, she was a post-doc researcher at the Department of Linguistics, Literature, and Communication Sciences of the University of Verona. She has been an honorary fellow at the Universities of Verona (2006-2007) and Bologna (2007-2008). From 2007 to 2018, she was an Assistant Professor in General Linguistics at the Department of Culture and Civilization of the University of Verona. Since April 2018, she has been an Associate Professor in General Linguistics in the same department. In 2023, she was awarded the National Scientific Qualification as a Full Professor in Linguistics.

Research: Her research interests cover the domains of morpho-syntax and lexical semantics, with a focus on the formal and interpretive properties of the morphologically complex lexicon. She has mainly explored word formation phenomena such as deverbal nominalisation, parasynthesis, zero-derivation, root compounding, and full reduplication, approaching them from a theoretical and comparative perspective (besides

Romance, Germanic, and Slavic, she has worked on Mandarin Chinese, Bantu, and Kwa languages). Other research subjects, mostly concerning the lexicon/syntax interface, include cognate object constructions and the modelling of polysemy in Generative Lexicon theory. Currently, she is conducting experimental research on first and second language acquisition. In particular, she is exploring the role of morphological and phonological knowledge and awareness in typical and atypical development (developmental dyslexia), and in monolingual and bilingual settings.

She is the author of *Event and Result Nominals: A Morpho-Semantic Approach* (2011, Peter Lang). She published articles in several peer-reviewed journals, including: *Annals of Dyslexia*, *Bilingualism: Language and Cognition*, *Frontiers in Psychology*, *International Journal of Bilingual Education and Bilingualism*, *Italian Journal of Linguistics*, *Journal of African Languages and Linguistics*, *Journal of Cognitive Science*, *Journal of Child Language*, *Journal of Language Acquisition*, *Journal of Linguistics*, *Journal of Word Formation*, *Languages*, *Lingue e Linguaggio*, *PLOS ONE*, *Studies in Language*, *Zeitschrift für Sprachwissenschaft*. She authored book chapters and articles in miscellanies published by De Gruyter, Benjamins, Wiley-Blackwell, Language Science Press, Oxford University Press, and Peter Lang.
