He also has considerable experience of drafting and negotiating commercial contracts and in advising in a wide variety of substantive and procedural rules and laws. He has been involved in a number of trials and bankruptcy proceedings, including a claim against the European Commission for a primary Italian corporation, a claim in front of the Queen's Bench Division in the United Kingdom on insurance matter with an important English law firm, a claim on the interest of the shareholders of a multinational corporation to neutralize a merger and a consequent delisting from the Italian stock exchange market, international arbitrations under the ICC rules, an acquisition from a big Italian company under extraordinary administration, many cases of unfair competition, liability of banks, board of directors, statutory auditors. He is also advisor for Italian insurance companies and very important bankruptcy procedures. He is often appointed as arbitrator by the President of the Tribunal of Milan on commercial and corporate matters.
