The main research interests of the Unit include:

- Pharmacoepidemiology, oriented to describe the beneficial and harmful effects of psychotropic drugs in ordinary practice;
- Randomized controlled trials, oriented to assess the efficacy and tolerability profile of psychotropic drugs in experimental conditions;
- Systematic reviews, oriented to summarize clinical trial findings using meta-analytical techniques.
Relevant achievements of the Unit include the development of a psychotropic register that collects information on psychotropic drugs prescribed within the South-Verona catchment area; the development of a network of Italian psychiatric services to collect data for multi centre studies; the development of tools oriented to assist the World Health Organization to improve the appropriate use of psychotropic drugs in low and middle income countries; the production of evidence based guidelines, covering the pathway from knowledge production to knowledge uptake in clinical practice.
