CURRENT POSITION

Simone Tentori is regularly enrolled in the second year of the PhD programme in European and Inter-national Legal Sciences at the Department of Legal Sciences of the University of Verona (cycle XXXVIII).

The research activity relates to the disciplinary field IUS/18 (Roman law and rights of antiquity) and is focused on the development of a research project entitled 'Studies on maritime trade in ancient Rome', under the supervision of Prof. Carlo Pelloso (as tutor).

He is also a practising lawyer at the Court of Verona, after a period of professional practice in civil and administrative law at the Court of Padua.

TRAINING

In 2015, he obtained his **high school diploma** at the Liceo Classico Elena Corner in Mirano (VE).

In April 2022, he **graduated** with a **single-cycle degree in Law** from the University of Padua with a grade of 110/110 *cum laude*, discussing a thesis entitled 'Questioni giuridiche inerenti al commercio marittimo in Roma antica' (Legal issues concerning maritime trade in ancient Rome), supervisor Prof. Luigi Garofalo and co-rapporteur Prof. Roberto Scevola.

In October 2022, he was awarded a scholarship in the **PhD** competition in 'European and International Legal Sciences' - Cycle XXXVIII at the Department of Legal Sciences, University of Verona.

In July 2024, he attended the **Salzburg Summer School 2024 on European Private Law**, at the University of Paris Lodron in Salzburg.

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

He speaks English and has a basic knowledge of French and Spanish, which he also reads fluently. He also has a good familiarity with classical languages.

- Since 2014, he has been a member of the AICC 'Italian Association of Classical Culture', delegation of Padua (previously, of Venice);

TEACHING ACTIVITIES

As of A.Y. 2022/2023, he will collaborate with the chairs of Carlo Pelloso (University of Verona), Paola Lambrini and Luigi Garofalo (University of Padua), and Roberto Scevola (University of Padua, also Treviso branch).

As of academic year 2023/2024, he will also collaborate with the chair of Tommaso dalla Massara and Sara Galeotti (University of

Roma Tre).

Within these collaborations, he carried out activities of:

- **Integrative teaching:**

In the year 2024, he won the tender for tutoring, **support and remedial work** in 'Institutions of Roman Law' at the University of Verona. From March 2024 to October 2024, the course involves a total of **40 hours of in-depth lectures** and exam simulations in preparation for the exam.

- **Lectures within the DSG of the University of Verona:**

In the academic year 2022/2023, he gave two lectures on the subject of possession and *animus possidendi* as part of the teaching of Romanistic Foundations of Private Law (Laurea Triennale in Servizi giuridici per im-prese, amministrazioni e no-profit – 6 cfu), under the supervision of Dr. Maria Federica Merotto, the course holder.

In the academic year 2023/2024, as part of the same teaching, he again held, under the supervision of the same, an additional lecture focusing on the same themes.

In the academic year 2023/2024, under the supervision of Prof. Carlo Pelloso, the holder of the course, he also gave two lectures as part of the Institutions of Roman Law course (Laurea Magistrale a ciclo unico in Giurisprudenza – 9 cfu), on the sources of cognition of private Roman law and the various parts of the *formula*.

Each lecture given lasted two academic hours.

- **Innovative teaching (Moot Court Competitions, Trial Simulations):**

Since 2023, he has participated in the selection and preparation of the members of the Verona team for the process simulation '**Moot Court Competition. Roman Law and Civil Tradition**', carrying out the preparation of practical cases from the Justinian Digest, solving and setting up the case, enhancing oratorical and argumentative skills and case reasoning. He also accompanied the individual members of the Verona team to the final competition.
