PROCEDURES

Nomination

Partner Universities must fill out our nomination file and send it by email to :

incoming-mobility@polytech.univ-cotedazur.fr

Application

The application procedure will be sent to the nominated students by email after the nomination period is over. The nominated students will apply through the **MoveOn platform** (a guide will be shared)

Required documents for application :

- Valid identity document
- Last transcript of records of current studies
- Latest diploma
- CV and Cover letter (in English)
- Signed Learning Agreement
- Language proficiency certificate

REQUIREMENTS

General information

- Semesters 5 & 6 correspond to Bachelor's level 3rd Year (Bac+3)
 - Semesters 7 & 8 correspond to Master's 1st Year (Bac+4)
 - Semester 9 corresponds to Master's 2nd Year (Bac+5) – First semester only
- International students can't apply for semester 10 (Second Semester of Master's 2nd Year).

Minimum Academic requirements

At least 2 years of university studies (Bac+2) at the time of the nomination.

Minimum Language requirements

Minimum B1 English + Minimum B1 in French (if students apply for courses in French).
The majority of courses are taught in French but it depends on the Departments.

Required document in the application : Language certificate (English and French) or a confirmation of language issued by a Partner University.

Credits per semester

30 ECTS / semester.

Choice of courses

All courses are generally open to exchange students as far as they meet the language and academic requirements.
