The Ernst Mach Grant is a scholarship option for applicants wishing to study at an Austrian University of Applied Sciences. The scholarship is targeted at undergraduates and graduates of all disciplines from **non-European countries**. The duration of the funded mobility has to be between four and ten months with the student receiving a monthly grant rate of €1300. Application deadline: February 1st for the following academic year.
