Short Story

Azerbaijan is a miraculous country with its abundant natural resources, centuries-old culture, history and ancient people, whose lifestyle presents a unique and harmonious combination of the traditions and ceremonies of different cultures and civilizations. Azerbaijan is one of the ancient sites of humankind. Its territory is rich with archeological monuments, which prove it to be one of the regions of first settlement. The first states or ethnic-political unions in Azerbaijan appeared around Lake Urmia at the end of 4th and at the beginning of 3rd millennium BC. States such as Manna, the kingdom of Iskit (Skit, Skif), Atropatena and Albania appear here in the first millennium BC. This fertile, generous and friendly land was the home for many thinkers, philosophers, scientists, poets, architects, musicians and artists. When Islam spread in Azerbaijan in the middle of seventh century, the country became one of the centers of Islamic civilization. Azerbaijan enriched Islamic and world civilizations with such geniuses as poet Nizami Ganjavi; philosopher Bahmaniyar; astronomer Nasreddin Tusi and many others. The late 15th and early of 16th centuries were very crucial for Azerbaijan when the prominent statesman Shah Ismail Khatai united all the territories of Azerbaijan under his control. In the late 18th and early of 19th century the war between Iran and Russia led to division of Azerbaijan between these two empires.

Following the collapse of the Russian empire, the Azerbaijan Democratic Republic (ADR) was established on May 28, 1918. The ADR was the first Parliamentary Republic in the history of the people of Azerbaijan, and the first democratic, legal and secular state in the Islamic world. Azerbaijan was the first among Muslim states and some European countries to grant women equal political rights with men. The ADR succumbed to the military attack of Soviet Russia in April of 1920. After over 70 years of Soviet occupation Azerbaijan's independence was restored in 1991 with the adoption of the State Independence resolution. With the collapse of the Soviet Union in late 1991, Armenian armed forces began military actions against Azerbaijan with the purpose of occupying Nagorno-Karabakh (the Mountainous Karabakh). By early 1994, some 20% of Azerbaijani territory including Karabakh was occupied by Armenian military forces. In 1993, the Security Council of the UN (Security Council) adopted resolutions 822, 853, 874, and 884 on the Armenian- Azerbaijani conflict. Each resolution was adopted as a result of the occupation of Nagorno-Karabakh and other territories of the Republic of Azerbaijan by the Armenian Armed Forces. On November 10, 2020, as a result of 44-days lasting war between Azerbaijani and Armenian military forces, Azerbaijan returned its occupied territories and restored its territorial integrity.



Baku, the capital city of Azerbaijan, lies along the Caspian Sea, and is a somewhat curious mix of the old walled city of Icheri Seher, and a modern building craze that has led a boom in skyscrapers. There are a number of interesting historical sites in Baku you may want to visit during your study in Azerbaijan.

Among the historical monuments of Baku, the most exciting one is the Old City - Icheri Sheher, surrounded by large fortress walls on three sides. It hosts the palace of the Palace of Shirvanshah built in 15th century and described by UNESCO as one of the pearls of Azerbaijani architecture which includes a complex of various structures: a mosque, mausoleum, hamam, divankhana, gates and reservoir.

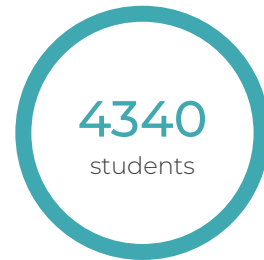


Another most magnificent and mysterious landmark in Baku is the Maiden Tower, or Gyz Galasi built in 12th century which is located in the heart of Old City. When you are standing on the top of the tower, you can actually see a great city view.

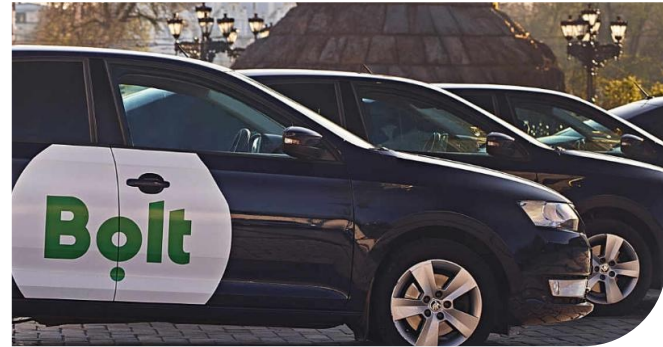

It gets overcrowded during the rush hours and using the subway is the most effective way to arrive everywhere on time. The travel cards can be purchased from all Underground Stations for 2 AZN per card. They are permanent and can be charged with any number of trips (50 qapik) (coins) per trip and recharged at any time.



Taxis can be ordered from several taxi services, or just flagged down on the street. There is no strictly regulated pricing system, but the approximate cost is some AZN 6 for any trip within the Centre of Baku. There are no meters in most of taxis, and it is recommended to negotiate the cost in advance. Only new taxis have meters (London Cabs). Prices for the planned directions could be also checked from the taxi services, such as applications or taxi provider numbers before ordering. Uber and Bolt are the most preferable taxi companies.

Buses go everywhere in the city and the one ride costs 40 qapik (coins) per trip (AZN 1=100 qapik (coins)). Destinations are usually posted on the front and the right side of the bus, or on the information screens of bus stations. Travel cards for subway can be used for buses as well. Additionally, some buses take cash for each trip. Buses can also take you to the regions (appr. AZN 8-12 depending on the distance), from the Bus Terminal in Bilajari.



Currency

The Azerbaijan currency is the MANAT (AZN) with the following exchange rates as of July 15, 2024. The exchange rate is subject to the change depending on the date. You can refer to the website of the Central Bank of the Republic of Azerbaijan to see the exchange rates.

Telephone services

The country code for Azerbaijan is +994. The area code for Baku is 12. Calls made within this area code are free of charge. Furthermore, telephone booths (public pay phones) are available for local calls all around the city, especially near the underground stations. To use them, you should purchase a card from the Telephone Exchange or from nearby shops and kiosks.

Cellular phones may be purchased and used locally. There are three mobile phone operators currently in Azerbaijan: Azercell (050, 051, 010), Bakcell (055, 099) and Nar Mobile (070, 077). GSM coverage includes the entire area of Azerbaijan. Due to high roaming charges, the best option for foreign visitors is to buy a SIM-card from one of the cellular phone operators. SIM-card normally also includes a local phone number. When purchasing a SIM-card, you will be required to show your ID since all the mobile numbers have to be registered. Top-up vouchers are also easily available.

Incoming calls are free of charge. To call a landline from a cellular phone, dial first '012' and proceed with a phone number. The call is payable.

To call a mobile phone from landline is payable.





- Products can be purchased from supermarkets but buying them in bazaars/open markets will be cheaper.
- Prices for household good are different in different markets.
- The water is usually safe in Baku and in the major towns, but it is not recommended to drink water from the tap.
- Main supermarkets in Baku: Bazarstore, Bravo, Araz (some of them work for 7/24).
- Mall shops in Baku: 28 Mall, Ganjlik Mall, Deniz Mall where you can find supermarkets, clothing, shoes, stores, traditional and fast-food restaurants, coffee shops etc.
- You can purchase cheaper cloths in the bazaars or the shopping centers in the areas that are located further from the downtown



Both public and private medical facilities exist in health system of Azerbaijan. Public polyclinics offer outpatient services, while hospitals and specialized clinics offer both outpatient and inpatient services.

Professional primary and secondary health care is available throughout Azerbaijan at private clinics and hospitals, which have modern equipment.

Private health insurance is voluntary in Azerbaijan. Insurance companies offer health insurance packages for the companies and individuals. They offer different packages, including emergency medical insurance. A health insurance package is usually valid for one year and covers both outpatient and inpatient services.

ADA Health Center provides medical service at ADA University. The center provides the medical services for students, faculty and staff and it is mainly designed to provide first aid services in case of illness and injuries including medications, injections, blood pressure measuring, temperature measuring, electrocardiogram, etc.

Furthermore, we usually recommend the international students to benefit from the services of "Medi Club" Hospital in Baku in case of need for any medical assistance. Below you can find detailed information about the hospital:

Visa

Travel to Azerbaijan requires an entry visa unless there is an agreement on visa free travel with the country of citizenship. Citizens of countries, which have visa - free regime agreement (www.mfa.gov.az) and citizens who have issued visa, only need to go through passport control once they arrive at one of the international airports of Azerbaijan.

ADA University urges its international students to apply for an e-visa (www.evisa.gov.az)

Important note: as a purpose of the trip indicate – Education.

Information about visa procedures for specific countries can be obtained from the respective embassies.

Important: If you are not eligible to apply for e-visa, you will need an invitation letter called “no objection letter” issued by Cabinet of Ministers to be able to enter Azerbaijan, based on the regulations issued by the government. International office gathers the necessary documents from those students who are planning their arrival to Azerbaijan and sends the documents to the responsible authorities to issue the letters. The length of time to issue no objection letters might take 2-3 weeks. By getting no objection letter, students will be able to apply for visa upon arrival at the airport. Students will need to pay 30 USD for visa fee at the Heydar Aliyev International Airport.

Arrival

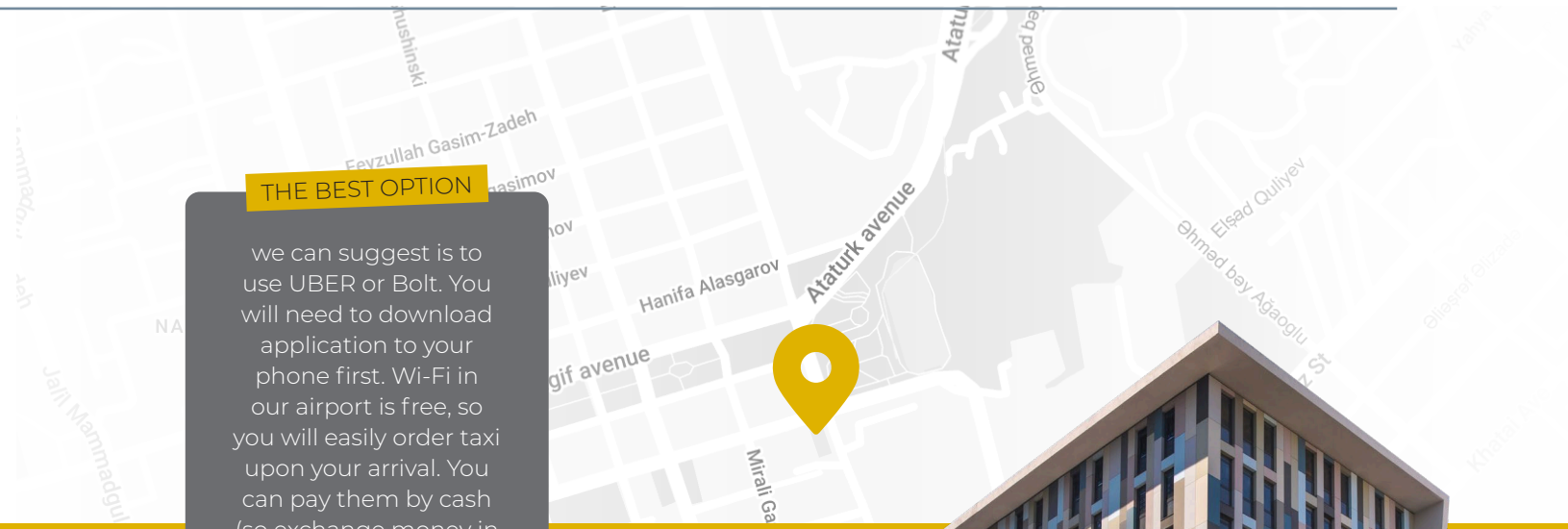
You can use different options to get from the airport to your place of stay.

From Airport to Univerium (accommodation): If you decide to stay at Univerium, the easiest way to travel from airport is by taxi or by bus.

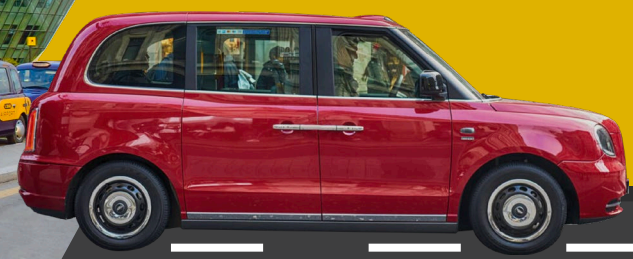
BY TAXI: Taxis are always available, and there is crowd of taxi drivers at the exit of terminal. The fare from airport to ADA apartments should be 15-20 AZN, but not more than that. You must discuss and agree on price with taxi driver before taking taxi. In Azerbaijani language 15 AZN is pronounced as - ON BESH MANAT, or 20 AZN- İYIRMI MANAT.

There are also London cubs and they have meters, so you may take them as well. Just for any case, check with them whether the meter is working.

THE BEST OPTION
we can suggest is to use UBER or Bolt. You will need to download application to your phone first. Wi-Fi in our airport is free, so you will easily order taxi upon your arrival. You can pay them by cash (so exchange money in airport) or by card (check your application for this option).

BY BUS: Here are the steps:

1. Exchange money in exchange point in airport building
2. Get BakıKart (plastic card) from loading machine (TVM) on your right or left after the exit of the building.<http://www.bakikart.az/en/6#66>. The card costs 2 AZN, but then you have to put money and increase the balance to use it in Baku buses and metro. One way ride will cost 0.50 AZN. However, the price from airport is 1.30 AZN. So, we would suggest after buying the card to upload about 5 AZN for future usage.
3. Take Airport Express at the bus station in front of entrance to the airport building. You can check the website for the bus schedule <https://www.aeroexpress.az/en>
4. Aeroexpress buses run from Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 to the Baku Railway Station (m/s "28th May"). Buses run from 06:00 AM till 11:15 PM every 20 minutes, and from 11:15 PM till 06:00 AM next day every 45 minutes
5. The bus will shortly stop near 28 May metro station. You can then take metro to Ganjlik metro station (which next station after 28 May), and you will get off in the Ganjlik area. You can walk from Ganjlik to Univerium and you will pass ADA University on your way. However, if you have heavy luggage, it will be a bit long and hard for you to walk. Maybe you can take taxi from there, or to take taxi from 28 May stay, which is also not far from Univerium
6. IMPORTANT: Metro is closed from 00:00 (24:00) till 06:00. <http://www.metro.gov.az/en>

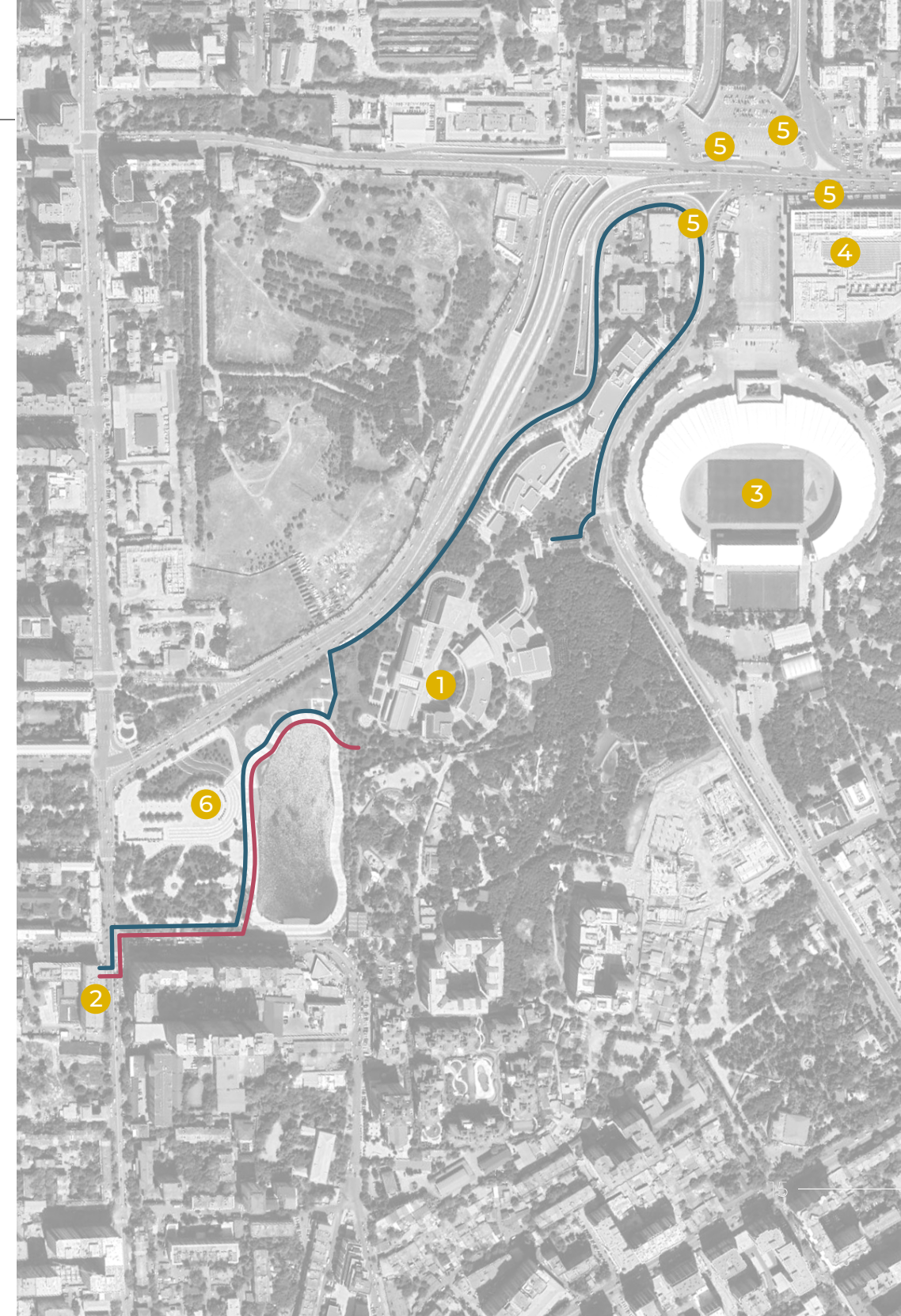

Registration

Within first 10 days of arriving in Azerbaijan all foreigners are required to register with the State Migration Services. The foreign students who are staying at Univerium dormitory will be registered by the dormitory responsible introducing the necessary documents. In the case of the students who are staying in the private accommodation must negotiate registration process with their landlord owners. If you fail to register on time, you will need to pay penalty up to 400 AZN.

Temporary Residence Permit

Upon arrival in Azerbaijan, students will have the standard 30 days visa. Then, after submission of the required registration form, our international students will be assisted in the process of receiving temporary resident status from the State Migration Service.

Ms. Gunel Allazova is Immigration, Travel, and Housing Administrator at ADA University (grmammadova@ada.edu.az) and contact person for visa, immigration and housing arrangements. All international students will receive the information about the requirements in details and assistance with the registration and application process for TRP and housing issue.

A buddy system at ADA university is a program that pairs older, more experienced students with the newly admitted students. The buddy is there to give the newly admitted international students a guidance and valuable advice for navigating their new life at the university, to improve the welcome phase and the integration of international students to their academic and social life in Baku.



The buddies usually arrange a pick-up service from the airport to the international students' accommodation, attend the city tours together, and offer their assistance in daily practical activities.



Buddies are usually assigned to the newly admitted students by the direct assistance of ESN ADA Baku and Topchubashov Fellowship Club members. The form with the listed volunteer buddies are sent to the newly admitted students so that they can choose a buddy for themselves.

ADA University does not have its own accommodation to offer the students. However, there are 2 student housings which ADA University is cooperating with in order to accommodate its incoming exchange and full-time international students.



Univerium (mainly exchange students)

- It is located 10 mins walk away from ADA University.
- It offers quadruple bedroom to the students, including canteen, conference room, movie room, sports hall, study rooms and music room.
- All utilities include electricity, water, internet, Cable TV, heating, beddings, towels, iron, dishes, vacuum cleaner are provided in apartments.
- The price is around **320 AZN per person, per month.**

Təbriz Evləri

- It is located 10 mins walk away from ADA University.
- It offers a single room (bedroom/ study room) to all students by sharing living room, kitchen and bathroom.
- All utilities include electricity, water, internet, Cable TV, heating, beddings, towels, iron, dishes, vacuum cleaner are provided in apartments.
- The price is around **400 AZN per person, per month.** Students are also required to pay **200 AZN security deposit. (It will be refunded.)**



The International Office (GOP) provides direct assistance to all incoming exchange and full-time international students to get accommodated in the student housings by sending the surveys to all admitted international students whether they would like to stay at the student dormitory arranged by ADA University or private housings.

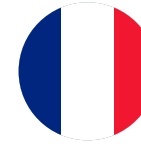
