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## *Academic Year*

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1st Semester: From September to February

2nd Semester: From February to July

## *Deadlines*

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Nominations to:

1st Semester (Winter)

Whole year

2nd Semester (Summer)

Until the end of April

Application Submission:

During May

## *Required Documents*

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The acceptance will depend on the existence of a bilateral agreement between the two institutions. It will only be considered the applications from students who have been nominated by the Sending Institution.

- Institution Nomination;
- Copy of the Identity Card;
- Proof of Health Insurance;
- Transcript of Records; Mobility Form;
- Portuguese Language Certificate B1 (Can be delivered until your arrival);
- Learning Agreement (OR) OLA – Online Learning Agreement – EWP dashboard.

## *Important notes*

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Learning Agreement and Mobility Form - Digital completion required. No hand-written documents.

On the Learning Agreement the student should indicate the disciplinary area name and ECTS credits individually according to our curriculum.

The Learning Agreement has to be filled in, only after having received validation from FMUL on the feasibility of the proposed curriculum plan, be signed by the Student, by the Local Institutional Coordinators and at the end returned to us.

30 ECTS is the maximum number of credits a student may select in one semester, and 60 ECTS is the maximum number of credits a student may select in one full academic year.



## *Optional Courses & Activities*

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Optional activities will no longer be offered to Erasmus students.

## *Student Nomination & Learning Agreements*

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If an institution nominates more than one student for a single semester, the students should not have the same proposed learning agreement.

## *Assessment and Attendance Requirements*

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All incoming students are expected to complete the final examination for their enrolled courses. Please note that attendance in Practical and TP classes (Small group classes) and the completion of tests throughout the semester are mandatory to be eligible for assessment.

## *Transcript of Records and Certification*

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At the end of each Erasmus mobility period, a Transcript of Records and a Supplement will be issued, detailing the number of contact hours completed. Consequently, individual certificates for each clinical placement are not required, as 4th and 5th-year students attend regular classes rather than internships.
