Requirements

Language requirements (if non-native in English or French-speaking country)



For programs offered in **English**, non-native students must justify one of the following:

- IELTS: 6.0
- TOEFL IBT: 4.5
- TOEIC: 780
- DUOLINGO TEST: 100
- Official certificate from English teacher or department



For programs offered in **French**, non-native students must justify a **B2 level** in any of the following:

- TCF
- TEF
- DELF (DALF)
- Official certificate from French teacher or department

Academic Requirements

Eligibility by Study Level in Science or Technology Fields :

- High School Diploma (or equivalent) → eligible to apply for Bachelor Y1 (B1)
- 1 Y. of Higher Ed. (or equivalent) → eligible to apply for Bachelor Y2 (B2)
- 2 Y. of Higher Ed. (or equivalent) → eligible to apply for Bachelor Y3 (B3)
- 3 Y. of Higher Ed. (or equivalent) → eligible to apply for MSc Y1 (M1)
- 4 Y. of Higher Ed. (or equivalent) → eligible to apply for MSc at MSc Y2 (M2)

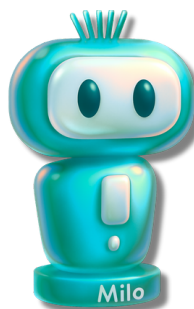
