## APPLICATION PROCESS

### FOR STUDENTS

Student nominations are revised by the International Office. Accepted students will receive their welcome letter.

# LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

## ENGLISH

**B1 certificate will be mandatory** if the student enrolls in classes in English. A specific language certification of exam type is not required. The certificate must be uploaded to the application form.

## SPANISH

**B1 certificate will be mandatory** if the student enrolls in classes in Spanish. A specific language certification of exam type is not required. Additionally, some courses in our degrees may require a B2-C1 level of Spanish. The certificate must be uploaded to the application form.

# LOYOLA FAQ'S



Can students take courses from different areas of study?

Are classes taught bilingually?

Yes, but the student will need to comply with prerequisites in each course. Please check the syllabus.

No, there are classes in Spanish and classes in English. The student will need to enroll in the classes that they are able to follow and present the exams in the corresponding language.

Can students take master courses?

Do you send exams to be done at the home university?

Undergraduate programs in Loyola are 4 years long. Master students from other universities are advised to take 3-4 year courses. Our Master programs are not open to receive exchange students.

No, exams are done face to face on the established date. There will not be any virtual exams either.
