### ADMISSION PROCESS

**Step 1:** The partner must send the list of nominated students via email at [m.banca@cesine.com](mailto:m.banca@cesine.com) and [international@cesine.com](mailto:international@cesine.com) including the student's **first name, last name, and email address**.

**Step 2:** Student registration. Students will then get a link (the home school is copied in) to register online and will have to upload the following documents:

- Copy of passport / ID Picture
- Language Proficiency: Business School - English B2 recommended // Design School - B1 Spanish required
- Last transcript of records
- Recommendation Letter & CV in English

**Step 3:** Once the application has been reviewed, the Admission Letter is sent to the students.

International Exchange Program with students from Partners University (Bilateral agreements & Erasmus+ agreements).

The list of courses is sent to students after their nomination and after the application form is finalised.

### Courses in the Design School:

-Fashion Design, Graphic Design, Interior Design  
-Language: DELIVERY in Spanish with only a few courses "English friendly" (English support + possibility to do the exams in English)

### Courses in the Business School:

-Advertising & Marketing, Business, Journalism\*  
-Language: **English** or Spanish (\*Spanish only)

**Credits:** up to 30 ECTS (1 semester)

## COURSE INFORMATION

**Welcome Week:** compulsory

**Class timetable:** Available a few days before the beginning of the courses.

**Grading System:** Spanish system for our Design Area / British system for our Business Area.

The Acceptance Letter is sent to students around late May (Fall Semester) and in November (Spring Semester).

**Re-sits exams:** Yes - in July (for all students)

**Transcripts:** Grades are available in the student platform three weeks after the final exams. Official transcripts are then sent to the home university and student.

### HOUSING

### HEALTH INSURANCE

Foreign students coming to CESINE must have medical insurance cover valid for their full stay. European Union Students must provide a copy of their valid EU health card.

Here are some Spanish companies that provide medical insurance for international students: Asisa, Adesla, Mapfre, Sanitas, Grupo AXA, Asisa, Mutua Madrileña, Allianz, Generali, SantaLucia, etc. Banks like Banco Santander, CAIXA, BBVA, Banco Sabadell, etc.

### COST OF LIVING: *(depending on student lifestyle)*

- Transport: 1,30€ per trip
- Housing: between 300€ and 500€
- Average monthly (without rent): 250-400€



### VISA

#### EU students:

Do not require a visa. They will have to register at the Oficina de Extranjería as EU residents.

#### NON-EU students:

Students must apply for a student visa. Once in Spain they have to apply, within 30 days of arrival, for a TIE - Identity number for foreign students (Student residence authorisation card).
