# Student's nomination and application procedures

## Online nominations for partner institutions:

First semester and full academic year: **from April 20th to May 22nd, 2026.**

**VISA:** Any student who requires a **study visa** must **be nominated before April 30th.**

Visa processing times have been extended. If these deadlines are not met, the visa may not be obtained on time. **It is not possible to apply for the visa from Spain.**

**NEW!:** Those second semester students who require a visa may be nominated during the period **from April 20th to May 22nd.**

Second semester and first semester extensions: **from September 21st to October 24th, 2026.**

**VISA:** Any student who requires a study visa must **be nominated before September 30th.** Visa processing times have been extended. If these deadlines are not met, the visa may not be obtained on time. **It is not possible to apply for the visa from Spain.**

The nomination will be carried out through [Mobility Online](#).

## Online application for students\*:

First semester and full academic year: **from April 22nd to May 29th, 2026.**

**VISA:** Students must **upload all required documentation before May 4th** in order to receive the letter of acceptance on time and apply for their study visa.

Second semester and first semester extensions: **from September 21st to October 30th, 2026.**

**VISA:** Students must upload all required **documentation before October 4th** in order to receive the letter of acceptance on time and apply for their study visa. **It is not possible to apply for the visa from Spain.**

\*Medical students are advised to seek prior review with the Academic Coordinator of Medicine.

# Internship's nomination and applications procedures

## Online nominations for partner institutions:

First semester: **from April 20th to May 22nd, 2026** (for internships taking place from September to December).

Second semester: **from September 21st to October 30th, 2026** (for internships taking place from January to July).

*Applications submitted outside these deadlines will not be accepted.*

**Internships cannot be carried out in August.**

**The nomination will be carried out through Mobility Online.**

**For internships, prior authorization from the Faculty's academic supervisor is required.**

## Requirements for exchange students

<p><b>Language</b></p>	<p>The language of instruction is Spanish. The minimum required level is B1 in Spanish, although a B2 level is recommended in order to follow classes comfortably.</p> <p>Courses taught in English require a minimum B2 level of English and are only available in certain fields of study. These courses have limited places.</p> <p><b>An official certificate or a confirmation letter from the home institution is required, stating the level of the language of the instruction.</b> Internships (Physiotherapy, Nursing, CAFYD, and Medicine): a minimum Spanish level of B2/C1 is an essential requirement.</p>
<p><b>Spanish Courses</b></p>	<p><b>Intensive Spanish Course (4 ECTS)</b> before the start of first semester classes, subject to a minimum number of enrolled students. Fees and information: <a href="mailto:idiomas@ufv.es">idiomas@ufv.es</a></p> <p><b>Spanish Course (6 ECTS)</b> Different levels (basic, intermediate, and advanced). Free course throughout the semester. Level assigned according to the results of the Spanish placement test upon arrival.</p>
<p><b>Health Insurance for students</b></p>	<p>Students are required: European Health Insurance Card for students residing in Europe, and private insurance covering healthcare, accidents, and repatriation of remains for students not residing in Europe.</p> <p><a href="#">Insurance</a></p>
<p><b>Health insurance for external internships</b></p>	<p>Students are required: European Health Insurance Card for students residing in Europe, and private insurance covering healthcare, accidents, and repatriation of remains for students not residing in Europe. Vaccination record and liability insurance.</p> <p><a href="#">Insurance</a></p>
<p><b>Visa</b></p>	<p>Additional documentation for students not residing in Europe: valid passport and study visa or valid European residence permit. MANDATORY presentation at the UFV Orientation Days.</p> <p><b>No student will be admitted without a study visa.</b></p> <p><a href="#">Ministry of the Interior – study visa information</a></p>
