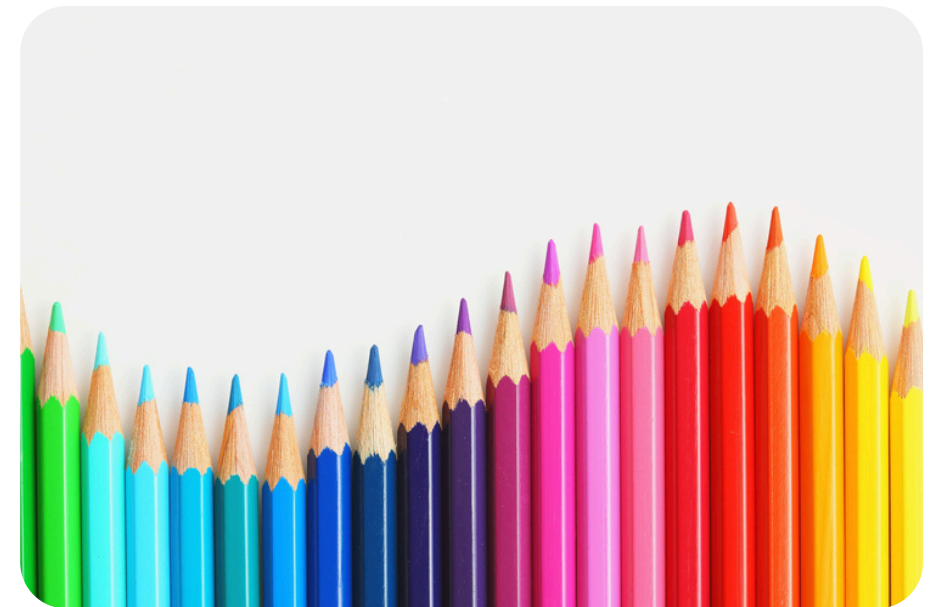

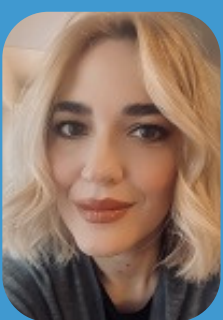

Anil Kandemir, Ph.D., is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Educational Sciences at Ağrı İbrahim Çeçen University, Turkey. He earned his doctoral degree from the Department of Educational Sciences at Middle East Technical University (METU) in 2023. His dissertation, titled “Landscaping Pre-Service English Language Teachers’ Identity Development: A Bourdieuan Perspective”, examines the construction of professional identity through the lens of social theory.

His research interests encompass teacher education, the sociology of education, teacher identity, higher education, institutional habitus, and curriculum evaluation. Dr. Kandemir has authored numerous book chapters, journal articles, and conference papers in both national and international venues.

Beyond his research, he actively contributes to the academic community as a member of the Board of Directors at the Turkish Association of Curriculum and Instruction (EPÖDER).
